Project title - East Midlands Gateway

INTRODUCTION

This letter is to introduce the East Midland Gateway Rail Terminal project that is due to commence in your area and provide you with an initial introduction to the project, give direction as to where to find out more information and a means of contact.

The project, East Midlands Gateway, aims to create 7000 new jobs and provides new rail and road connected distribution and storage facilities including;

- · An intermodal freight terminal
- Up to 557,414 m2 (6m sq ft) of rail served warehousing and ancillary service buildings;
- A new rail line connecting the terminal to the Castle Donington branch freight only line;
- New road infrastructure and improvements to the existing road infrastructure;
- Strategic landscaping and the creation of new publicly accessible open areas;
- · Bus interchange.
- New dedicated Bypass for Kegworth giving direct access to the A453 and the M1

TIMELINE

We will commence the infrastructure works early January 2017 for approximately a 3 year construction period with the majority of highway works to be completed within the first 2 years. If you wish to be included in the project updates please contact the construction team.
